




CONTRACT FOR TEACHING SERVICES OF ADJUNCT PROFESSOR

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This contract made and entered by and between:



The VISAYAS STATE UNIVERISTY (VSU), an institution of higher learning established under Pres. Decree No. 470 as amended by Pres. Decree No. 700 and converted into a state university by virtue of R.A. 9158 and 9437, with principal office at Baybay City, Leyte, duly represented by its, President, **DR. PROSE IVY G. YEPES**, hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY;

Dr. Antonio P. Abamo, of legal age, married, Filipino and with residence and postal address at Brgy. Guadalupe, Baybay City, Leyte, Philippines, hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY, particularly the Department of Business and Management presently lacks graduate faculty due to the study leave/retirement/leave/resignation of professors handling graduate courses.

WHEREAS, the Department of Business and Management is offering a graduate program, Master of Management.

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY is in dire need of professors who can teach graduate courses which can be taught only by professionals in the field who meet the minimum academic qualifications of a graduate faculty as specified in Section 3 of the Graduate School Code.

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY is in need of one with the desired expertise who will teach AMGT209 (lec) course/subject at the Department of Business and Management, VSU, Baybay City, Leyte effective 2nd Semester, SY 2024-2025 good for 64 actual contact hours.

WHEREAS, in spite of vacancy announcement, nobody responded to said vacancy, due to the very low hourly pay of only P320.00 given to part-time faculty with a doctorate degree.

WHEREAS, due to the urgency to hire the needed faculty, the SECOND PARTY was requested to serve as Adjunct Professor to handle the above courses having been a Graduate faculty while still connected with the university.

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY possesses the needed expertise to undertake the aforementioned job and is willing to be paid on a per hour basis;

WHEREAS, the SECOND PARTY is willing to handle the courses as Adjunct Professor at an hourly rate of P440.00 as provided for in BOR Res. No. 39, s. 2014 and BOR Res. No. 35 s. of 2015.

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered, the parties hereto have hereby agree as they have agreed under the terms and conditions, to wit:

THAT the SECOND PARTY shall serve as Adjunct Professor to handle the following subjects effective 2nd Semester, SY 2024-2025.

THAT the SECOND PARTY hereby undertakes the aforementioned job under the direct supervision of the FIRST PARTY or duly authorized representative: such as:

- 1. Prepare learning materials for the classes assigned.
- Conduct classes as scheduled,
- 3. Conduct make-up classes in case of absence or officially declared class suspensions,
- 4. Employ varied teaching strategies to enhance the student learning,
- 5. Apply/conduct applicable modes of assessment of student learning,
- 6. Maintain an updated and orderly class record of all classes handled,
- 7. Conduct examinations and other appropriate performance assessment tasks, and give relevant assignments and other course requirements,
- 8. Return corrected test papers and other assessment outputs to the students, and provide regular feedback to students on their class performance for improvement,
- 9. Perform other tasks that may be assigned by the Department Head or the College Dean to facilitate or enhance student learning,
- 10. Attend to student queries and other class-related concerns even outside class hours,
- 11. Attend/participate in orientation and seminars and other instruction-related activities conducted/spearheaded by the university to improve their teaching competencies,
- 12. Compute and submit grades and turn over class records to the Department Head on or before the deadline of grade submission,
- 13. Turn over complete hard copies of class records, data, learning materials, equipment, and other things that come into his/her possession because of his/her job to the department after the end of the semester. Hard copies of class records shall be turned over to another faculty or to the Department Head. In case of INC grades of some students, details on when and how the students can complete the grades should be provided.
- 14. Pass clearance at the end of semester.

THAT for and in consideration of the foregoing job to be performed on a flexible class schedule, the FIRST PARTY agrees to hire and pay the SECOND PARTY of P440.00 per hour to be paid on a monthly basis and the details of the payment shall be as follows:

1. The computation for the rate/subject/semester will be as follows:

Rate/subject/semester = No. of units X credit hours/unit/semester X hourly rate

- The total number of hours to be paid per semester shall not exceed the maximum contact hours of her/his teaching load for the 2nd Semester, SY 2024-2025 as certified by the University Registrar.
- 3. Monthly payment shall be supported with a Daily Time Record (DTR) and accomplishment report of the performance by the SECOND PARTY certified by the Department Head of all the mandated teaching jobs as enumerated in the preceding paragraph, sub. par. 1 to 11.
- 4. Last month's salary shall likewise be supported with a certification from the Department Head that the SECOND PARTY complied with his/her teaching functions in the preceding paragraph, sub. par. 12 to 14 re: submission of grades, class records and clearance to the Department Head.

THAT, it should be understood that an Adjunct Professor is not allowed to participate in the administrative affairs of the university. He/she may attend meetings but is not allowed to vote.

THAT for and in consideration of the foregoing job, the FIRST PARTY agrees to pay the SECOND PARTY for services equivalent to the required total number of hours of service as certified by the Registrar which should be in accordance with the prescribed schedule of classes, unless there is an approved changes thereto.

THAT the SECOND PARTY is required to turn-over all class records, data, learning materials, equipment, and other things that come into his/her possession because of his/her job, and preserve the confidentiality of any information regarding the University, faculty, staff, and students. Any disclosure and divulgement of confidential information (including personal information kept on computer or other media, research, technologies and manuals) made unlawfully outside the proper course of duty will be grounds for dismissal without prejudice to filing of appropriate case in Court.
