Interpretations

The client, a 56-year-old woman, came into the clinic presentable and wellgroomed. She was wearing a blue shirt with collar, maroon trouser with white stripes, a pair of black slippers, and a black sling bag. Upon the time of the evaluation, the client appeared to have good contact with reality and was oriented to person, place, and time. Furthermore, her affect was congruent to her mood and her thought process was coherent and goal oriented. She had a normal speech rate and volume. She behaved well and was cooperative in answering the questions asked by the clinician. There was no display of involuntary movements. However, during the assessment it was observed that she displayed limited eye contact and had difficulty in comprehending instructions. She demonstrated a reluctance to ask questions and continued to answer despite difficulty in understanding some of the items. Furthermore, the client reported that she is currently residing at Molave Street, Kamputhaw with her son from her second partner. According to her, she had a former spouse who passed away in 2002 due to alcoholism. They were married for 18 years and had five children. Five years later after her first husband's death, she had a livein partner and they have been together for five years and had two children. Unfortunately, in year 2012 her live-in partner also passed away due to hypertension. Regarding her work experience, the client expressed that she has been a housekeeper in Manila for 6 years. She also had an experience as a caregiver for a paralyzed elderly person for three years and has been a child caretaker for 2 years. However, she stopped working and decided to go back to their province and built a small business. In 2017, she began her employment as a caretaker on a lodging house owned by VSU (Visayas State University). Currently, the client is still working at the Lodging House at Molave Street, Kamputhaw as Caretaker.

Additionally, overall result of the test showed that the client has the tendency to display noticeable confusion, gets easily distracted, and is disorganized. She may have trouble remembering even simple things from day to day. Also, she may feel like life is dreamy and may see a big difference between self and others. Moreover, she may tend to display behavior patterns that are different from most people and at the same time, she may acknowledge having unusual and concerning traits

Recommendation

Overall results of the test show that the client has high elevation on the *Thinking Disorder and Deviation* scales of the BPI seen at the time of the evaluation. She may seek a mental health professional to check on her issues. However, she is recommended for the position that she is applying for.
