3. Fill in this form completely and accurately.

4. For correctness and accuracy of data, the mother or the father shall be preferred as informant over any other person.

5. The informant shall be asked to sign item 14 of this form upon completion. Before doing so he should review the entire form and make sure that the entries made therein are all correct and that the names of the child and of the parents are correctly spelled.

6. Section 14 refers to whether or not registration is delayed. If delayed, place date and place of delay.

Section 7 - False Statements: Any person who shall knowingly make false statements in the forms furnished and shall enter the entry in the civil register, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one month nor more than six months or a fine of not less than two hundred pesos nor more than five hundred; or both, in the discretion of the court.

Section 8 - Failure to Report Other Violations: Any person whose duty it is to report any fact concerning the civil register and who knowingly fails to perform such duty, and any person convicted of having violated any of the provisions of this Act, shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten nor more than two hundred pesos.

Section 9 - Record of Offenses: In case of the violation of this Act, any local civil registrar who fails properly to observe his duties as regards compliance with the provisions of the Act and if the regulations issued hereunder, shall be punished for the first offense by an absolute stricture fine in no way equal to his salary in the year that he was charged with the same matter and for a second or repeated offense, by removal from the service.
