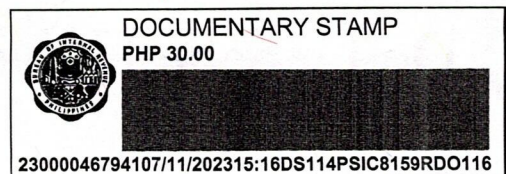

### Calendar

### Transfer Credit

Transfer credit is awarded for a course taken at an accredited institution which is equivalent to a course offered at De La Salle University.

Transfer credits appear on the student's record with the name of the institution, course title, and number of credits.

Only the grades in courses taken in De La Salle University shall be included in the computation of the Grade Point Average.

### Transcript Entries

Only courses taken at De La Salle University and transfer credits appear on the Transcript of Records.

The entries for entrance data only reflect those which are pertinent to admission into the current program.

### Graduate Studies/Second Degree

This section of the document displays only the school and the degree earned in support of admission to the current program.

### Undergraduate Studies

In the case of transfer students - those with incomplete studies - the previous school is likewise reflected.
