The Governing Board thanked Dr. Dar for successfully leading the SCP during the selection process and for the very thorough SCP Report.

# B. BOR Interview of the Candidates for the VSU Presidency

The Governing Board then proceeded to interview the three (3) candidates for the VSU Presidency: Dr. Othello B. Capuno, Dr. Roberto C. Guarte, and Dr. Edgardo E. Tulin. Each candidate was interviewed by the members of the Governing Board for not more than 30 minutes.

## C. Election and Appointment of the New VSU President

Chairperson Licuanan informed the members of the Board that based on the Guidelines, the candidate who gets 50% +1 votes or seven (7) votes, all in all, will be the new VSU President. In the event that after the first balloting, no candidate gets this number of votes, a second round of voting will be done following the Guidelines.

The Hon. Chairperson announced that the voting will be by secret balloting using the specific form prepared for this purpose and designated the Board Secretary to do the "canvassing of votes" and the Student Regent, the tabulation of votes.

The Governing Board then proceeded to cast their votes.

After the GB members marked their ballots, the Board Secretary collected their ballots and then proceeded to read the name indicated in the ballots. After all the ballots were canvassed, Dr. Edgardo E. Tulin got the required number of votes.

The Governing Board ushered in the three (3) candidates and announced the results of the votation and that Dr. Edgardo E. Tulin was able to secure the required number of votes to be appointed as the new VSU President.

## V. New Business under Agenda Proper (Part II)

## A. Chairperson's Time

The Hon. Chairperson, Commissioner Maria Cynthia Rose B. Bautista, informed the Board that there is a felt need for SUCs to help in the offering of the different tracks – <u>Academic, TecVoc Livelihood, Sports, Arts and Design</u> – under the K+12 program. Included in Academic track are the following strands: **STEM** (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics), **HumSS** (Humanities, Social Science), and **ABM** (Accountancy, Business and Management). Agriculture, however, has been incorporated under the TecVoc track.

The CHED will be holding a Strategic Planning Workshop for the Visayas on November 3, 2015 in Cebu. A CHED Memo will be issued this coming Monday for this. Up for discussion will be the Faculty and Staff Development Plan. The initial 2-year period of the transition period of the K+12 is a rare opportunity for HEIs in general and SUCs in particular, to upgrade the professional advancement of the faculty and staff.

The Hon. Chair commented regarding the query of the Student Regent earlier about the need to designate Deans in all the Colleges of the University.

The Hon. Chair pointed out that the academic culture in the SCUs is very different from that in the private setting. In SUCs, the Vice-Presidents are not "above" the Deans because in reality they are the "staff" of the President. The Vice-Presidents "help the President" coordinate with the Deans and other officials of the University. The academic line starts with the President, then the Deans, then the Department Chairmen, and then the teachers themselves. Thus, one-year designations will be appropriate. The University has to polish up its Guidelines on the Selection and Designation of College Deans in the soonest possible time..

## **B. NEW BUSINESS**

# 1. Sabbatical Leave Application of Prof. Jacob Glenn F. Jansalin

The Board Secretary informed the Board that the Sabbatical Leave application of Prof. Jacob Glenn F. Jansalin will start this coming 01 November 2015 until 31 October 2016.

Chairperson Bautista inquired whether this was coursed through the usual processes in the University.

The Board Secretary replied in the affirmative.

The Hon. Chairperson inquired if there were any objections regarding the Sabbatical Leave applicaatin of Prof. Jansalin commencing on 01 November 2015 until 31 October 2016.

No objections were raised.

## 2. Offering of Senior High School (SHS) by VSU

The Hon. Chairperson informed the Board that the Board has already approved the offering of Senior High School by way of a Resolution.

The CHED has already issued the Guidelines governing the offering of Grades 11 and 12.

The Board Secretary commented that in the case of VSU, the "teachers who are expected to teach" the subjects in Grades 11 and 12 are not regular facultybut rather part-time faculty only. Given that the University will be able to access only 50% of the proposed "student voucher expected to be P18,000.00 for Eastern Visayas", the University will have to spend part of its income just to be able to pay for the salaries of the part-time teachers who will be assigned to teach in the Grades 11 and 12.

Chairperson Bautista commented that this is the first time that she has been made aware that VSU needs to hire part-time teachers to be able to offer Grades 11 and 12. In the other SUCs, there are enough regular faculty who can do the teaching work.

Nonetheless, this will later be borne out when the Faculty and Staff Development Plan will be discussed during the upcoming Strategic Planning Workshop for the Visayas this coming 03 November 2015 in Cebu.
