MINUTES OF THE 12TH BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING HELD ON APRIL 19, 1976, AT THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY'S CONFERENCE ROOM, DEC, MANILA

Acting Chairman Suarez called the meeting to order at 12:45 p.m.

Before the minutes of the previous meeting had to be taken into consideration, President Bernardo made known to the Board

the presence of Dr. Samuel S. Go who had been designated Officer-in-Charge of VisCA for the duration of his official trip to Peking. In behalf of the Board members, Acting Chairman Suarez recognized Dr. Go's attendance at this meeting.

On motion duly seconded, the Board confirmed the minutes
of the meeting on March 25, 1976 with the following modifications: (1) Page 2, line 2 -- corrected the spelling of "opened"
to "opined"; line 3 -- deleted "for" after the word "proposed";

(2) Page 3, lines 13 & 14 -- inserted "confidential" after
the word "certain", cancelled the phrase "about his morality"
and placed a period after "questions".

II. With respect to matters arising from the approved minutes,
Acting Chairman Suarez reminded Vice-President Jesena, Jr. to
be ready with the Jeep Flan proposal that was approved in
principle. In addition, he suggested that subsequent minutes
of the Board be typewritten double-space.

13 III. Budgetary Matter

The members went over the items of the proposed budget for the 1976 Summer Vacation Classes. In reply to the queries of Acting Chairman Suarez whether the Acting Librarian is qualified and that of Board Member Perez the reason behind adopting two modes of paying the professors and instructors their honoraria (hourly rate and 75% of the basic monthly salary) during summer, President Bernardo answered the former

1		negatively and apprised the latter on the ground for resorting
2		to the two schemes of payment. Acting Chairman Suarez
3		remarked that budget-wise, the proposal is a self-liquidating
4	1	project. On the other hand, President Bernardo informed the
5		Board that any excess of this budget will go to the general

13		Acting Chairman Suarez read one by one the names of
14		additional appointments of personnel for comments. There-
15		upon, Board Member Perez asked for a clarification concern-
16		ing the difference between the salary rate of Mr. Edilberto
17		Nasayao in the Department of Forestry and that of Mr.
18		Nestor Gloria of the Department of Agronomy and Soils.
19		President Bernardo disclosed that the Department Chairman
20		usually recommends the salary rates for instructors
21		depending on the availability of positions and seeing to it
22		that a balance is maintained within the department. He
23		further added that as far as Mr. Gloria is concerned,
24		this staff member who is a new BS graduate with major in
25		agronomy and whose background is teacher-training will only

1	assist a senior staff member; whereas, Mr. Nasayao,
2	although just a year ahead of the former, is really a
3	forester; hence, the higher salary rate given the latter
4	especial consideration is also given to the fact that
5	qualified recruits along this line are not readily avail-
6	able.

1	President Bernardo elucidated on the objectives of the trip
2	in the light of integrating applied research and extension
3	program of ViSCA. He also mentioned that the first trip to
4	be undertaken by him will identify the areas applicable for
5	implementation at ViSCA, while the trip of the two staff
6	members who will leave about the middle of May will be an
7	in-depth study of the areas previously pinpointed. Because
8	of limited funds, only two more ViSCA staff members can make
9	the observational study in China this year.
