Interpretation of the Logo

- The large bold outer circle represents the Leyte State University
 which embraces the inner circle and represented by the College
 of Education and Agricultural Technology operating in
 consonance and within the bounds of the mission and vision of
 the university.
- The white background stands for clarity and transparency in the attainment of the college goals and the implementation of its programs and projects.
- The green color which is the university color compliments with the blue color which symbolizes the Villaba Campus as a teacher training institution.
- The symbols of the book and tractor represent the twin thrusts of the college which are education and agricultural technology respectively.
- 5. The year 1947 indicates the year that the school started its operation as Villaba High School under the General Education Program while 1999 signifies the year when the school is integrated to LSU system as an external campus.
- 6. The gold background in the inner circle symbolizes the bountiful and productive endeavor of the college in turning out graduates in accordance to its curricular offerings.
- 7. The black letters printed in the middle of the inner circle indicate the acronym of the college, which stands for College of Education and Agricultural Technology. As shown in the acronym, the line connecting among letters E, A and T signifies the unification and straightforward commitment of the college to strengthen the programs and foster progress and development in both fields of Education and Agricultural Technology.
