WHEREAS, the Visayas State University is an institution of higher learning established under Presidential Decree No. 400 as amended by Presidential Decree No. 700 and converted into a state university by virtue of Republic Act 9158 and renamed as Visayas State University by virtue of Republic Act 9437;

WHEREAS, Section 7(b) of RA 9158 specifically empowers the VSU Board of Regents to "receive and appropriate all sums as may be provided, for the support of the University in the manner it may determine, in its discretion, to carry out the purposes and functions of the University";


