Aside from attending seminars & trainings, faculty members also need to visit beautiful sceneries/places of which their experiences would be consulted important inputs to instruction.  An amount of 30,000.00 is allocated for the Faculty and Employees' Sportsfest. This acitivity is a real application of the statement which says "All works and no play makes Jack a dull boy."  Graduation is an indispensable activity of the school since it marks an important milestone for students who have satisfactorily completed all the requirements as prescribed in their respective courses. There are several expenditures for this important affair, hence an amount of P18,000.00 is allotted for this purpose.
		One important facility of the school is the comfort room. It is the vision of the school to provide a permanent comfort room for each classroom. Most classrooms have already their own comfort rooms except the SEF building, DECS building, and the Technology building which are located in the upper campus. Since these buildings have 10 classrooms, construction of the said comfort rooms will be done on staggered basis. An amount of P9,923.13 is allotted for the construction of 1 comfort
