Madam:

I have the honor to request for authority to continue the collection of the Computerization Fee of P1,200.00 per student per semester at the College of Agri-Industrial Technology, Isabel, Leyte.

LSU-Isabel has deemed it necessary to continue assessing this amount in view of the need to acquire more computer equipment and accessories as well as on account of the rising operational cost in maintaining the present computer equipment. There has been a marked increase in student enrolment in the Bachelor of Science in Information Technology (BSIT) and in the Associate in Computer Technology (ACT). As a result, more computer units for instruction are needed in order to be able to serve the needs of the students.

It may be recalled that the BSIT is now on its third year of offering and that BSIT students need to have more hands-on time as stipulated in their curriculum. The number of computer units at present is inadequate for the needs of the BSIT major students and ACT students considering that all the other students are also required to take computer courses.

The provision of continued high quality of instruction in the BSIT, ACT, and the other degree programs in the LSU-Isabel Campus would very much depend on the ability of the campus to keep on expanding and upgrading its facilities.

It is, with much hope, that this request merits your favorable attention and approval.
